The Granite air ride suspension offers an ideal combination of stability and driveability. A back-of-cab crossmember is Huck® bolted to the chassis for greater strength and integrity.

The Granite cab is full of amenities with the leg and belly room to accommodate any driver. The contoured dash, the multidirectional steering column and ergonomic pedal placement all provide unmatched comfort. Frequently used controls are in easy reach.

Keeping streets clear of snow gets a little easier in the Granite snowplow. You'll appreciate the inside/outside air intake, heated mirrors, 20-inch frame extension and special snowplow hood with inspection latch. Auxilliary lamp provisions have been made for dash control and power supply for installation of snowplow light. Keep the powerful ASET™ engine warm with a Phillips® 120-volt heater. You can even heat the windshield for better driver visibility and improved safety.

The aerodynamic lines of the Granite hood offer excellent visibility and low coefficient of drag for better fuel economy.

Mack components — step brackets, cable mount air tanks and battery boxes — are all permanently positioned forward of the rear of the cab. Body compatibility is ensured. There's no expense for moving components.



Two 19-pin industry-certified Body Link™ wire harness connectors are located on the firewall under the hood and dash panel for quick hookup.



Stylish air intake hood grilles and advanced air filtration systems combat harsh conditions while cooling the engine.

Thoughtfully-engineered doors feature concealed hinges to keep dirt out and a handle that performs double-duty as a pull. The passenger door is available with an oversized peep window for greater visibility.

Our Vehicle Information Profiler (V.I.P.™) is a large in-dash display that keeps drivers notified about engine/vehicle performance, fuel economy, and trip data as well as maintenance and PTO information. Our optional GuardDog™ maintenance monitor tells drivers when engine oil and selected filters need to be changed and when fluid levels are low. Maintenance data comes through real-time sensors instead of preprogrammed schedules based on mileage. GuardDog gives you the information you need to help avoid unplanned downtime.
